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The manuscript should be prepared in the following order: (1) Title, (2) Abstract, (3) Keywords, (4) Introduction, (5) Materials and Methods, (6) Results and Discussion, (7) Acknowledgements, and (8) References.

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The title should be on the first page and provide precise information about the contents. Title should not exceed 120 characters (space included). The title should be followed by the list of author(s) and affiliation(s).
